RE: Nomination Call for Delegate to the 40th IBEW International Convention

Brothers and Sisters

The 40th IBEW International Convention is scheduled to take place Monday, May 9 through Friday, May 13, 2022 in Chicago Illinois. The International Convention is normally held every five years and is the highest governing body of the IBEW. It elects all International Officers and determines the basic law of the IBEW by its votes on proposed resolutions and constitutional amendments. It is also the final authority on appeals.

The 2351 bylaws specify that the President/Business Manager serves as the Local's Convention delegate by virtue of their office, and the ballot for President/Business Manager also specifies "Delegate to the International Convention". In the event the elected Business Manager is unable to attend the International Conference, an elected alternate may attend.

The elected Business Manager for Local 2351, will not be attending the Convention. Given Local 2351 does not currently have an alternate delegate elected, one needs to be elected, ASAP, to ensure that person can be registered with the International as the Local 2351 Delegate to the International Convention.

This letter serves as a call for Nominations for the position of International Convention Delegate. The Nomination process is as stated below.

- Nomination Period
 Starts 12:01 am, January 11th, 2022
 Ends Midnight January 26th, 2022.
- Members may self-nominate if they wish to.
- Nominations and self-nominations may be submitted through email to ibew2351@nf.aibn.com and cc b.manager2351@bellaliant.com

In the event there is more than one nomination for Delegate, an election (as per Local 2351 by-laws) will be held at the Union's Monthly General Meeting, February 1, 2022. The person receiving the highest number of votes will be the elected International Convention delegate, the person receiving the next highest would be the first alternate, the next highest the second alternate, and so on.

The requirements to run for convention delegate and/or alternate

- (Article 2, section 10 of the Constitution specifies that to be eligible they must be in continuous good standing in the local Union for at least twenty-four (24) months prior to nomination).
